Course Structure

Session 1: Introduction to Burn Injuries

- Registration Ice breaker (trainer & participant)
- Welcome and introduction to the course
- Overview of burn injuries: types, causes, and severity
- Understanding the importance of immediate first aid for burns

Session 2: Assessing the Burn Injury

- Triangle of fire
- Identifying the different degrees of burns (first-degree, second-degree, third-degree)
- Recognizing the signs and symptoms of burn injuries
- Understanding the importance of assessing the size and depth of the burn

Session 3: Immediate Response and Safety Measures

- Ensuring personal safety and the safety of others in the vicinity
- Explaining the STOP, DROP, and ROLL technique for extinguishing clothing fires
- Teaching the correct response to different types of burns (thermal, chemical, electrical)

Session 4: First Aid for First-Degree and Second-Degree Burns

- Providing step-by-step instructions for treating first-degree and small second-degree burns
- Demonstrating the proper techniques for cooling the burn and relieving pain
- Discussing the appropriate use of over-the-counter burn creams and ointments
- Covering the importance of protecting the burn with a sterile dressing
